Top Story: The Heidelberg College volleyball team is making its second-straight trip to the Division III Volleyball Championships, all of which have come via an at-large bid. The 2008 Ohio Athletic Conference Runner-ups in both the regular season and tournament boast an overall record of 30-7, which marks a single-season record for wins. It was the third-straight season, and fourth time in five years, that Heidelberg has recorded over 20 wins in a season. Ninth-year head coach **Jason Miller** helped guide the Berg to five postseason wins, either OAC tournament or NCAA, in the last two years after being winless in 15 matches.

NCAA Notes: The 2008 team joins the 2007 team as the lone 'Berg volleyball campaigns to find themselves in the NCAA Championships. In 2007, Heidelberg took part in the Wittenberg Regional where it topped Rochester Institute of Technology 3-1 (30-22, 30-22, 21-30, 30-18) in the quarterfinals before falling to no. 1 Wittenberg 3-0 (30-20, 30-15, 30-25) in semifinal action. Of the 61 teams in the championship bracket, Heidelberg faced seven teams on the year for a total of nine matches. In those nine matches Heidelberg was 4-5. Included on that list is fellow Oshkosh Regional foes Calvin and Hope. The Berg topped Hope 3-2 (23-25, 25-16, 25-20, 14-25, 15-10) Oct. 31 and fell 3-1 (25-22, 22-25, 15-25, 18-25) to Calvin Nov. 1.

OAC Honors: Heidelberg placed a program-best five players on the All-Ohio Athletic Conference Team, along with claiming two player of the year honors. Voted the Libero of the Year was sophomore **Brittany Donelan**, while newcomer outside hitter **Jackie Reinhart** was tabbed the Freshman of the Year. Donelan earned a spot on the second team, while Reinhart picked up honorable mention honors. Senior outside hitter **Emily Hurlburt** and junior setter **Morgan Magers** were named to the first team after earning a spot on the second team and honorable mention list a season ago, respectively. Rounding out the list of all-league performers is senior outside hitter **Audra Vucic** with a nod on the honorable mention team.

Academic Excellence: Heidelberg prides itself on its success on the court, along with in the classroom. Four student-athletes earned *ESPN The Magazine* Academic All-District IV College Division honors recently. Earning a spot on the first team was **Brittany Donelan** (business administration) and **Morgan Magers** (education), while **Emily Hurlburt** (education) and **Kelsey Elliott** (public relations) were third team recipients.

Record Breakers: Not only has Heidelberg broken the record for wins in a season, but numerous players have inked their names in the record book. **Emily Hurlburt** became only the fourth player to record 1,000 career kills and sits third at 1,157. Her 435 on the year ranks fifth. **Brittany Donelan** has picked up 782 digs, which is second in a single-season, and increases her career total to 1,180, which is sixth. Donelan is just the 11th player to pick up 1,000 digs at Heidelberg. For the third-straight season **Morgan Magers** dished out at least 1,000 assists (1,354) and owns the top-three single-season records and is the career record holder at 4,192. **Jackie Reinhart** has served up 59 aces, which ranks fourth, while **Audra Vucic** moved into fifth on the career list for kills with 860 and Hurlburt is fourth in blocks with 361.
