

UW-Oshkosh Women's Volleyball Notes

- UW-Oshkosh is making its fourth consecutive and 13th overall NCAA Division III postseason appearance.
- UW-Oshkosh won its first WIAC Tournament championship since 1994 with a 25-21, 23-25, 25-17, 22-25, 15-12 road win over UW-Eau Claire on Nov. 8.
- UW-Oshkosh shared its third WIAC regular season title in the last three years this season with UW-Eau Claire. The Titans were also co-champions in 2005 with UW-Whitewater and in 2006 with UW-Eau Claire. The Titans have won a total of nine WIAC regular season titles.
- The Titans have won 30-plus matches the last four years for a combined 137-19 record (.878 winning percentage). UW-Oshkosh has had 16 seasons of 30 or more wins and six years of 40 or more victories.
- Heading into the Oshkosh Regional with only two losses, UW-Oshkosh is guaranteed the fewest losses in team history. The previous mark of five was set in 1990 (44-5) and tied in 1995 (41-5), 1996 (40-5) and 2005 (36-5).
- With its two victories in five-sets in the semifinals over UW-La Crosse and in the finals to UW-Eau Claire in the WIAC tournament, UW-Oshkosh improved to 10-0 in five-set matches this season.
- Christina Cahoon (So. • Watertown) became only the second libero in WIAC history to be named as a first team selection when she was named to the 12-member team. UW-Oshkosh's Samantha Schmidt was the other, when she was a member of the 2007 first team.
- UW-Oshkosh has five players who have registered 200-plus kills this season, Megan Fischer (Jr. • Manitowoc) with 317, Jacque Ray (Jr. • Richland Center) with 278, Andrea Smith (So. • Fond du Lac) with 265, Ashley Sullivan (So. • DeForest) with 226 and Kelsey Mauer (Fr. • Sheboygan Falls) with 218.
- Valerie Yost (Sr. • Oshkosh), the Titans lone senior on the team has compiled 89 kills on 213 attempts for a .279 hitting percentage. She has also added 34 blocks in 63 games played.
- UW-Oshkosh is a perfect 13-0 this season at home.
- Last season, UW-Oshkosh set the NCAA Division III record with 57-consecutive sets won. This season, the Titans' longest consecutive sets won streak is 16.
