**Determination Of Home team**

## **Pre-Game Format**

The home team will take infield of 10 minutes at 40 minutes before the game's scheduled start. The visiting team will take infield of 10 minutes at 30 minutes before the game's scheduled start. Field preparations will take place 20 minutes before the game's scheduled start. Umpires and coaches will meet at home plate 5 minutes before the game's scheduled start. Player introductions and national anthem will take place following the meeting at home plate. On the first and final day, all players and coaches will be introduced. On the days in between, only the starting lineup and head coach will be introduced. Players and coaches should lineup along the foul line for introductions when their name is announced.
