University of Wisconsin-Eau Claire Notes

- Blugolds are making their 12th appearance in NCAA post-season tournament
 - Fifth consecutive
 - Made it to the third round in 2005 and 2006; second round in 2008; first in 2007
 - Holds a 10-11 all-time record in NCAA post-season play
 - NCAA post-season records against teams in Oshkosh regional and last meeting in ()
 - St. Benedict, 0-2 (Nov. 14, 2008 – Blugolds lost 3-1); Luther, 0-0; St. Norbert, 0-0; St. Olaf, 0-0; St. Thomas, 0-1 (Nov. 8, 2007 – Blugolds lost 3-1); UW-Oshkosh, 2-1 (Nov. 11, 2005 – Blugolds won 3-1); UW-Whitewater, 1-5 (Nov. 11, 2006 – Blugolds lost 3-1)

 - Blugolds are 2-3 against teams in Oshkosh Regional this season (1-2 vs. Whitewater; 0-1 vs. St. Benedict; 1-1 vs. Oshkosh)
- Blugolds currently ranked 16th in AVCA poll; have been in every poll this season; highest was 13th twice (Sept. 8 and Sept. 15)
- Blugolds have posted 20 or more wins in 11 consecutive seasons and 17 out of the last 18
- Including this season, the Blugolds have posted 30 or more victories 10 times in their history
- Eau Claire has won 11 out of its last 12 matches
- Finished second at WIAC Tournament, defeating UW-Oshkosh in the semifinals and falling to UW-Whitewater in the final
- Finished tied for third in the WIAC standings with UW-Platteville and UW-River Falls
- Blugolds have done well at neutral sites this season, posting a 10-2 record. They are also 9-3 in away matches and 11-2 at home.

- Eau Claire in WIAC Stat Categories
 - Eau Claire and Oshkosh tied for leading conference in blocks (2.20/set)
 - 3rd in hitting percentage (.214), 3rd in assists (11.44/set), 3rd in kills (12.52/set), 5th in service aces (1.41/set), 6th in digs (15.09/set)
 - Liz Amici leads WIAC in blocking (1.22/set)
 - Kristen Moore and Danielle Lucia 4th and 5th in hitting percentage (.311 and .299)
 - Emily Neave 5th in assists (7.42/set)
- Head Coach Kim Wudi
 - In her third year leading the Blugolds
 - Holds a 76-30 record with the Blugolds (.717 winning percentage)
 - Has led Eau Claire to the NCAA Tournament each of her first three seasons
 - WIAC Co-Coach of the Year in 2008 after guiding EC to WIAC Co-Championship
