

## NCAA Division III Women's Volleyball Championship • Oshkosh Regional

### University of Wisconsin-Whitewater Notes

The Warhawks are making their twenty-second, and eighteenth consecutive, appearance in the NCAA III Tournament

UW-Whitewater won NCAA III titles in 2002 and 2005, finished second in 2000, 2001 and 2007, were third in 1995 and fourth in 1988 and 2006

UW-W hosted the NCAA III final four (semifinals and finals) in 1995, 2000, 2001 and 2002

The 1995 matches were played at Whitewater High School because the end line in Williams Center (now Kachel Gym in Williams Center) was not the required distance from a wall. That problem was corrected with the construction of the volleyball arena in the renovation of Williams Center and expansion into Kachel Fieldhouse during the 2000-2001 school year

Head coach Stacy Boudreau, who came to UW-W in 2005, won the NCAA III title in her first year. Now in her fifth season, she has directed Whitewater to two Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference titles (2005, 2007) and three WIAC postseason tournament championships (2006, 2007, 2009)

Boudreau is 175-32 entering the 2009 regional, a winning percentage of .845. Boudreau is on the same pace in WIAC play, 34-6 for a mark of .850

Boudreau was the NCAA III Volleyball Coach of the Year in 2005 and the WIAC Volleyball Coach of the Year in 2007

Boudreau has coached six players to a total of seven All-American honors in her first four years

Caitlin Hogan (outside hitter) and Keri Klotzbuecher (outside hitter) were First Team All-WIAC picks in 2008 and 2009. Melissa Zuleger (middle blocker) joined them on the first team this season

Berkley, the senior libero, is the sister of assistant coach Amanda Berkley

Winning is in the water. While assistant coach Heather Zebrowski is with the volleyball team, husband Jim is the offensive coordinator of the Warhawk football team, ranked second nationally

Making their mark: In the Warhawk record book ...

The 2009 team had 21 service aces in a win over Marian University September 4, the school record.

The 2009 team had 125 digs in a loss to Carthage College October 30, fifth best all-time

Alyssa Bauer is:

Second in career matches with 20+ digs, with 28

Third in season digs, 683 this year

Seventh in career double figure digs, 66 matches

Has six of the top ten single game dig totals (36,36,34,34,32,31)

Tenth in career digs, 1,291

Alyse Karls is tenth in career assists, 2,130

Melissa Zuleger had a hitting percentage of .824 versus Wheaton College (Sept. 5, 2009), third in the record book

Tournament tough.

UW-W played 18 matches, going 13-5, against NCAA III tournament teams

UW-W played UW-Eau Claire three times, losing 3-1 September 1, winning 3-0

October 16, and winning 3-0 in the WIAC Tournament championship match

UW-W split with UW-Oshkosh, losing 3-1 September 23, winning 3-1 October 23

UW-W split with Carthage College, winning 3-0 September 25 and losing 3-2 October 30

UW-W defeated UW-Platteville twice, 3-1 October 6 and 3-0 in the WIAC Tournament semifinal November 6

UW-W defeated Pacific Lutheran 3-1 September 11, defeated Ohio Northern 3-2

September 12, lost to Washington University 3-2 September 12, defeated Heidelberg

3-2 September 26, defeated Chapman 3-1 October 9, lost to LaVerne October 9,

defeated New York University 3-0 October 10, defeated Saint Norbert 3-0 October 23,

and defeated Simpson 3-1 October 31
