Registration – Mail in registration with payment. No phone or fax registrations will be accepted. You will not receive any confirmation of your registration.

Directions – From Highway 41, exit on Highway 21 East into Oshkosh (exit 119). Follow Oshkosh Ave over the Fox River Bridge to High Street (first stop light after the bridge). Turn right onto High Street (one way street). Kolf Sports Center is the large brick building on the right. You may park in any of the parking lots near the building.

Check-In – Check-In will begin 45 minutes prior to each session.

What to Bring – Each player is required to bring a glove, batting gloves, bat (optional), sweatshirt or jacket, sweat pants and tennis shoes.

Facilities – The camp will be held in Kolf Sports Center. The fieldhouse includes two large batting cages and regulation size infields and outfields. Facilities include an additional double gym with a batting cage, lecture rooms and videotaping area.

CAMP STAFF

Cindy Suess – UW-Oshkosh Head coach. Cindy Suess is entering her sixth season as the Titan's head coach. Suess was selected as the Wisconsin Intercollegiate Athletic Conference Coach of the Year in 2007. The Titans won the 2007 WIAC Conference Championship and 2008 Conference Tournament. Suess led the Titans to the NCAA Regional Championship in 2007 and 2008, finishing second both years. Suess has the highest winning percentage of any softball coach in UW Oshkosh Softball history.

Craig Stevens – UW-Oshkosh Assistant Coach. Stevens is in his fourth year with the Titan Softball program. He brings a vast amount of collegiate experience to the Titan Softball program, including his head softball coaching position at Bemidji State University. He has also worked several baseball camps for the University of Nebraska-Lincoln.

Graeme Robertson – UW-Oshkosh Assistant Coach. Robertson is in his sixth season and works with the UW-Oshkosh pitchers and catchers. Robertson coached two of the top pitchers in the WIAC, including a four time WIAC Pitcher of the Year, an NCAA All-American, NCAA All Region selections and WIAC All-Conference selections. Robertson is a former New Zealand National Team pitcher and USA/ASA Male Softball Athlete of the Year. Robertson has competed in several Major ISC World and ASA National Tournaments. He has also been selected to the ISC All-World and ASA All-American teams.

Sara Hampton – Former UW-Oshkosh Assistant Coach. Hampton has been an assistant for the Titans for three seasons. She spent her college years playing for Division II Minnesota State University, Mankato and was a First Team All State Catcher at Verona Area High School.

Steve Krupke – Brodhead High School Softball Coach. Krupke led Brodhead to a 2004 State Championship & conference titles from 2000-2004, 2006 and 2009. As a men's fastpitch player, Krupke was a member of the 2006 ASA Class A and NAFA National Championship teams. He is also a pitching instructor in the Madison area.
