Baseball School Format: Grades (9-12)

Dear Fall Baseball School Player,

The UW-Oshkosh Coaching Staff would like to invite you and your teammates to share in the great tradition of Oshkosh Baseball. As a player, you will gain the knowledge and learn the drills to reach your peak performance on the baseball field. Due to the small amount of athletes allowed at the Fall Baseball School, your instruction will be individualized and very specific to enhance your development.

Head Coach and Clinic Director, Tom Lechnir is the All-time leader in WIAC Baseball with a career record of **689-255-1 (.730)** In his **23 years** as a Head Coach he has produced one **National Champion (1994)**, **11 NCAA World Series teams**, **11 NCAA Regional Champions**, **16 NCAA Regional appearances**, and **13 Conference Championship teams**. In Coach Lechnir's 33 years with Oshkosh baseball as a player and coach the Titans have posted a **956-320 Record (.750)**.

* Assistant clinic director, Bruce Schreiber enters his second year as an Assistant coach. Bruce was a four-year starter, and two-time All-American at Oshkosh.

* Assistant baseball coach **Brian Gerl** returns for his fifth year to assist with the pitching staff after lettering at UW-Oshkosh for 4 yrs.

* Current Oshkosh baseball players will assist the baseball school staff.

Each **Fall Baseball School Clinic** will follow the format that combines individual drill instruction with **on-the-field** playing instruction.

All clinics will include instruction and drill work as they relate to pitching, fielding and hitting.

Players will focus on live drills to increase their hand-eye coordination, body balance, swing path, arm path, fielding technique, flaws, and mental approach.

Players will focus on throwing, swinging, and defensive mechanics and their techniques as it relates to pitching, catching, infield, and outfield play.

Players will focus on situational drills and fundamentals for offensive and defensive baseball.

Players will focus on learning specific off-season workout drills. Hitting, throwing, strength and conditioning, as well as speed and agility drills specific to their position.

All Players will be grouped by age.

Grades (4-8)

Players will focus on live drills to increase their hand-eye coordination, body balance, swing path, arm path, fielding technique, flaws, and mental approach. Introductory drills that relate to strength and conditioning and speed and agility.

Players will focus on throwing, swinging, and defensive mechanics and their techniques as it relates to pitching, catching, infield, and outfield play. Situational drills and fundamentals for offensive and defensive baseball will be taught.

* Each clinic will include an on the field 1.5 hour competitive game.

* Attending the clinics will provide the player the information they need for a complete off-season workout program.

* Players will participate in a personal video session critique as well as an analysis of major league players.

* Player to coach ratio is 3 to 1.
