General Information and Enrollment

This camp is open to **all boys entering grades 8 through 12.**

***NOTE: the NCAA now permits graduated high school seniors eligibility for participation in this camp.

Enrollment for camp will be limited and on a first come, first served, basis. Anyone interested in registering after July 1 must first call the sports camp office at (920) 424-0294.

Camp priorities will be to:

- Physically and mentally prepare players for the challenges of your upcoming high school season.
- Players from the same high school can train together as a team so that tactical and positional training can carry over into your high school season.
- Provide technical and tactical instruction that high school coaches won't have the time for.
- Positional play will be continually addressed within the context of daily training and game experiences.
- Blend an ideal balance of technical and tactical training with playing experiences throughout the entirety of the camp.
- Present and discuss opportunities to play college soccer and how to make useful and proper contacts with college soccer coaches. Evening sessions will be devoted to these and other applicable topics.

On Titan Soccer

- NCAA tournament appearances include four Final Four, four quarterfinal, six sweet sixteen finishes. Including, national ranking in 18 of the past 23 years.
- Last fall's season marked the 26th consecutive winning season for the UW-Oshkosh Titans.
