The UW Oshkosh Coaching Staff would like to invite you and your teammates to share in the great tradition of Oshkosh Baseball. As a player, you will gain the knowledge and learn the drills to reach your peak performance on the baseball field. Your instruction will be individualized and very specific to enhance your baseball development.

Head Coach and Clinic Director, Tom Lechnir is the All Time leader in WIAC Baseball with a career record of **689-255-1 (.730)** In his 23 years as a Head Coach he has produced one National Champion (1994), 11 NCAA World Series teams, 11 NCAA Regional Champions, 16 NCAA Regional appearances, and 13 Conference Championship teams. In **Coach Lechnir's** 33 years with Oshkosh baseball as a player and coach the Titans have posted a **956-320 Record (.750)**.

* Assistant clinic director, **Bruce Schreiber** enters his second year as an Assistant coach. Bruce was a four year starter, and two-time All American at Oshkosh.

* Assistant baseball coach **Mickey Fadness** returns to his alma mater to begin his coaching career. He was a four year starter for UWO. Mickey was also a three time All Conference Player.

* **All members of the 2012 team will assist the coaching staff** and work with players on their individual skill development.

CLINIC 1 & 2 FORMAT

First 2 Hour Session

Players will receive instruction on Hitting. Instruction will include: drills to build a hitter, big league hitting drills, drills to correct flaws, drills to take home, and strength and conditioning as it relates to hitting.

Third Hour Session

Players must choose a specific position i.e. pitching, infield, catching, or outfield play. They will receive instruction in that specific area.

Fourth Hour Session

Players will receive an overview of arm path and fielding techniques and drills.

CLINIC 3 FORMAT

First 2 Hour Session

Players must choose a specific position i.e. pitching, catching, infield, or outfield play. They will receive instruction in their specific area. Instruction will include: footwork technique as it relates to each position, specific skill enhancement drills, coordination and agility drills to increase athletic balance and quickness, along with arm path technique as it relates to each position.

Second 2 Hour Session

Players will receive instruction on Hitting. Instruction will include: drills to build a hitter, big league hitting drills, drills to correct flaws, drills to take home, and strength and conditioning as it relates to hitting.

* **All members of the 2012 UW Oshkosh Baseball Team and Coaching Staff will serve as instructors.**

* **Camper to coach ratio is a minimum of 4:1.** Sessions for coaches will be held in one of the lecture halls in Kolf Sports Center. Those sessions will cover pitching, hitting, and defensive drills and philosophies.

CLINIC FEES

FACILITIES

Kolf Sports Center's spacious facilities enable us to cover infield, outfield, catching, pitching and hitting. Enclosed in the fieldhouse is a regulation infield completely enclosed by netting, double batting cage, batting tees, and six indoor pitching mounds. Three large gymnasiums are available to provide added instruction areas.
