Specifics:

\$25.50 per room, per night for college dorm style rooms.

Parking

There is not a fee for parking for friends and fans. For those playing at UW-Oshkosh, buses can park in the parking lot on Pearl Ave. across from River Commons after dropping off players and coaches. For those playing at Oshkosh North High School buses can park in the east lot where you drop off the teams. Teams should enter the building using door #20 by the tennis courts.

Concessions

Food and beverages will be available. We will have Cousin's Subs, Gatorade, soda, pizza, water and other snacks. Please do not bring in a ton of carry-ins. Concessions prices will be reasonable.

Training Room

We will have trainers available in case of emergencies. Please bring your own supplies.

We will have an all-tournament team so please fill out your ballots after each match and put it in the envelop that will be at each scorers table. 32 all-tournament team individual plaques will be awarded plus gold bracket champions and runner-up team plaques.

Kolf Sports Center - Gyms A & B and Field House

Near Kolf Sports Center Gyms A and B is a gymnastics gym that is off limits. We will have the dividing door open to allow for more room for play, but we can't have anybody in the gymnastics gym at anytime. Further, all mats for the high jump and pole vault in the Kolf Sports Center Field House are also off limits.

Admission

Adults: \$5.00 per day

Senior Guests: \$3.00 per day (55 and older)

High School Students: \$2.00 per day with School ID

Kids 7-14: \$2.00 per day (6 and under free)

Coaches, Players, Managers, Athletic Trainers and Bus Drivers will be admitted free to the tournament. Please do not take advantage of this.

Warm-up

First time playing on each day teams get six minutes of shared court time, then each team gets six minutes of court time. After each team has played once each team gets four minutes of court time, no shared court time. Albee Hall teams can use the racquetball courts to warm-up and there is room in the Kolf Sports Center Field House.

Results

We will have poster boards in Albee Hall, in Kolf Sports Center Field House, Kolf Sports Center Gyms A and B and at Oshkosh North High School for each pool. Results will be posted as soon as possible after the matches are completed.

Format and Schedule

See attached sheets for format and schedule. Included with this are tie-breaking procedures. Each team is guaranteed at least six, best two out of three matches. Bronze, Silver and Gold Bracket championship matches are scheduled for 5:00 p.m. on Saturday night. Teams were placed into pools based on conferences and WIAA Divisions. Teams that participated in the 2010 UW-Oshkosh High School Showdown were guaranteed to be playing at UW-Oshkosh for pool play. Teams participating in their first Showdown were placed into pools and either assigned open spots at UW-Oshkosh or at Oshkosh North High School.

Locker Rooms

We have two locker rooms with limited space for your usage. Signs will direct you to where they are when you get here. There are not lockers available so we ask that your team takes their belongings with them after they change, etc. Showers are available in each locker room. Towels are not provided.

Lodging

****Each team must supply two line judges, a scoreboard operator and libero tracker for each match they are officiating for both pool play and playoffs.**

Tiebreaking Procedure For Pool Play

Two way Tie Head to Head

- Three or More Tie 1. Sets Won/Loss Percentage Among Tied Teams
 2. Sets Won/Loss Percentage Among all Teams in Pool
 3. Point Differential Among Tied Teams
 4. Point Differential Among all Teams in Pool
 5. Coin Flip

After pool play teams will be placed into one of three, 12-team single elimination bracket playoffs based on seeds. Teams will be placed into which bracket based on the above criteria within their pool and then seeded within the bracket based on the following:

1. Matches Won/Loss Percentage
2. Sets Won/Loss Percentage
3. Point Differential
4. Coin Flip

The teams that take first in each pool will be compared and take the 1-6th seed and the teams that take second in each pool will be compared and take the 7-12th seed. The same will be done for the silver bracket (3rd and 4th-place teams) and the bronze bracket (5th and 6th-place teams) for playoffs.

Gold Bracket Playoffs 1st and 2nd-place teams from each pool Field House - Wood

Silver Bracket
Playoffs 3rd and 4th-place team from each pool Kolf - Gym A & B

Bronze Bracket
Playoffs 5th and 6th-place teams from each pool Kolf - Sport Courts
